SNCF/RENNES TEST RUN IN 2018 YIELDS POSITIVE RESULTS

From May to July 2018:

An NFC pass good for travel on all transport modes in the STAR network serving the Rennes metropolitan area was sold on the SNCF app.



Customers were enthusiastic: over 8 in 10 testers recommended the service and expressed a wish to add in other mobility services












PARTNERSHIP WITH MAJOR CITIES IN FRANCE STARTING IN 2019
